

WHAT IS A GROUP RELATIONS CONFERENCE



The Conference is a temporary organization with the aim of exploring and learning from experiencing conscious and unconscious processes as they manifest in the “here-and-now”, when authority, leadership and followership are exercised. The intention is to generate new thoughts and new learning and to review our knowledge and values; we have the opportunity to experience ourselves in multiple and different roles. Assistance is provided for an actual and sustainable change in interpreting the different roles in one’s organization and in life, particularly the roles that require an exercise of authority and leadership.

THE CONFERENCE METHODOLOGY

The organization of the Conference and the activities proposed to participants generate an experiential learning. This means learning from its own live experience of group and organizational processes, which promotes self-reflective skills and encourages a spirit of inquiry. Participants, along with the staff, can critically examine different experiences, working behaviours and interpreting the roles of leaders or followers.

This type of training has no therapeutic intent and can sometimes be stressful. For this reason, it is recommended to people at a time of emotional stress or difficulty in their personal lives to postpone their participation to next edition.

THE 2022 CONFERENCE

THE PRIMARY TASK OF THE CONFERENCE IS

Learning, from the experience of taking up roles in a temporary organisation, the conscious and unconscious dynamics of authority, leadership and followership when restarting from the vortices

For the fifth time the focus is the Mediterranean, as shared matrix of many countries and cultures, as a gathering place or container of many of the individual, group and societal dynamics that we can observe today in the life of organisations, businesses, cultures, in societies and in the relations among countries.

TRAINING GROUP

This edition includes up to a maximum of 10 places reserved for the Training Group (TG): a pathway that helps understanding the processes that develop in the GRC and to deepen one's competence in knowing how to recognise and manage them. The TG is aimed to who has already attended at the least two GRC and who is interested to further develop this type of learning and to then apply it in one's professional life. A specific programme for the TG is designed that combines the experience with space for reflecting on the experience.

LANGUAGES: Italian, English

The Conference is bilingual, Italian participants are required to have some knowledge of English; the translation of some parts of the Conference would be made available using the resources available in the system both among the staff and the participants in a spirit of collaboration, focus will be given to the learning of the language of the unconscious, of the emotions and of the non-verbal. It will not be easy, however based on experience we can confirm that not always rationally understanding the literal translation has helped the experience learning in the Conference.



Dear Potential Participant,

when it seemed that the world was slowly exiting the pandemic crisis the winds of war from the East have become a full on. The war in Ukraine has brought to Europe and beyond the realisation that unsolved conflicts may generate wars. The war in Ukraine is deafeningly over imposing itself on the measures that the national governments and the expectations of their citizens seemed to activate for restarting social and economic lives. The fear of a constant and prolonged suspension of organisational, institutional, and commercial activities and of human relations seemed almost avoided, people feel a push and a desire to get back, to return, to restart. Borders reopen and close, offices are reactivated, clubs, cinemas and places are repopulated. Will everything be like before?! Will new scenarios develop? What does sustainable mean? What will be included and what will not? Will a generational succession/transition take place? Or the pandemic, dramatically associated to the climate and economic crisis (eco-logical and eco-nomical, having the same etymological root in "eco" thus "home"), have started processes of deep change that are not fully manifested? How will the world, the governments, the countries, and their people deal with this dramatic crisis coming from the East of Europe? The way individuals, groups, organisations, and communities are consciously and/or unconsciously equipping themselves for the various restarts will shape these changes and provide the measure of the degree of the developed resilience.



The 24th GRC ALI Restarting from the Vortices – Regenerative Authority, Leadership and Followership will be in presence and intends to be an opportunity for exploring how authority, leadership and followership can be exercised for facilitating the exiting from a long and intense period of turbulences and the returning to a sustainable wellbeing in organisations, businesses, and institutions we belong to. For the fifth time ALI will take place in the Mediterranean and in Sicily, a land of hybridisation and historical, geological, and mythological turbulences. An active volcano, constant “invasions” from the sea – more or less pacific – a channel where two seas join and put mythological crews between difficult choices, all represent a scenario of resilient places and people where you, potential participant, will be warmly invited with others to take up or, better, to re-take up regenerative roles exploring their conscious and unconscious dimensions.
